	Level One Waiver	<i>Services Provided:</i> Homemaker personal care, respite—institutional, respite—informal, specialized medical, adaptive equipment and supplies, transportation, environmental accessibility adaptations, emergency response system, day habilitation, supported employment, emergency services

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<b>Ohio Department of Aging</b>	PASSPORT	<i>Services Provided:</i> Homemaker, personal care, emergency response systems, chore services, social work counseling, nutritional counseling, home-delivered meals, adult day health, specialized medical equipment and supplies, transportation, independent living assistance, environmental accessibility adaptations
	Choices Waiver	<i>Services Provided:</i> Home care attendant, adult day care, home-delivered meals, emergency response system, medical equipment and supplies, environmental accessibility adaptations, pest control, alternative meals service
	PACE <i>(Program of All Inclusive Care)</i>	<i>Services Provided:</i> Primary and secondary care, adult day health, personal care services, occupational and physical therapies.
	Assisted Living Program	<i>Services Provided:</i> Assisted living services, community transition services
	Home First Initiative	<i>Services Provided:</i> Allows seniors who are in a nursing facility to be assessed and given the opportunity to transition to in-home care. Same services as PASSPORT.



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## WHO CAN BENEFIT FROM HOME CARE

### A person...

- discharged from a hospital or a nursing facility who needs additional care at home;
- requiring short-term assistance at home because of outpatient surgery or maternity-related incapacity;
- needing additional assistance to live independently due to illness, disability or aging;
- with conditions such as congestive heart disease, diabetes and muscular, nervous or respiratory disorders; or
- who is terminally ill and want to spend their remaining time in dignity and the comfort of home.

## WHO PROVIDES HOME CARE?

The team of caregivers is usually comprised of physicians, social workers, registered nurse (RNs), licensed practical nurses (LPNs), therapy specialists (physical, occupational, and speech therapists), dieticians and pharmacists, home care aides and chore workers/companions, family members, and/or volunteers.

**Hospice provides** a specialized interdisciplinary program designed to provide palliative care to the terminally ill, and supportive care for the primary caregiver and family members.

## WHO PROVIDES HOSPICE?

The team is usually comprised of Registered Nurses, Social Workers, Physicians, clergy and other counselors, home care aides, family members, trained volunteers, physical, occupational and speech therapists.
