### **Why attend?**

An older Ohioan falls every two minutes and sustains a fall-related injury every five minutes, resulting in two hospitalizations each hour, an emergency room visit every eight minutes, and three deaths each day. Falls are the number one cause of injury-related emergency room visits, hospitalizations and deaths among adults age 65 and older, and these falls cost Ohio more than \$4.2 billion each year. This interactive symposium presents the causes and implications of falls from multiple perspectives (Physiological, Psychosocial, and Environmental); as well as introduces STEADY U Ohio, an innovative state-wide initiative that uses a 360° approach to prevent falls.

Rooms must be booked by Friday, March 7 in order to receive the \$89.00 (plus tax) group rate, which includes continental breakfast.




